DROP OFF DAY PREP

Whitecourt residents will be required to show their Landfill Access Tag to receive free disposal. Two pieces of identification showing your Whitecourt street address will also be accepted (i.e. driver's licence, tax notice, utility bill, etc.).

All items must be sorted, and bagged or bundled for disposal.

Residents will be responsible for unpacking and placing items in designated areas at the Landfill so be sure to wear appropriate footwear for the Landfill.
