Cool off at the Splash Park with interactive spray toys for action-packed water fun. The park features three different play zones: Discovery Bay for infants, toddlers and their caregivers; Adventure Bay with dump buckets, spraying arcs and loops; and Action Bay with water spray guns for high-energy play - all on a rubberized concrete play surface.

Join in the fun, or sit on one of the relaxing benches or under the sun shelter while the kids play. The Spray Park will provide hours of enjoyment for all ages!

Whitecourt River Slides

The Whitecourt River Slides at Rotary Park are open during the summer months for family enjoyment. The water feature includes two man-made creeks with a series of pools and drops for tubing and play, with a shallow basin and beach at the end of the creeks.

Daily: 10AM - 9PM (weather permitting)

September 1 - September 30

Weekends Only: 10AM - 7PM (weather permitting)

*The Splash Park & River Slides may be closed Wednesday mornings from 10AM - 12PM (noon) for routine maintenance

The slides will be open when the outside air temperature is sixteen-degrees Celsius (16°C) or above, weather permitting. If sixteen-degrees Celsius (16°C) is not reached by 2PM the slides will not open.
