

Whitecourt ADVISORY BOARD

TAKE PART, GIVE BACK

MANDATE: To create a healthy, strong community by meeting the leisure and social needs of the community.

The Committee consists of:

- 1 Town Council Representative
- 1 Woodlands County Council Representative
- 5 Public Members must be residents of Whitecourt or the agreement area of Woodlands County (at no time shall the number of public members from Woodlands County exceed those from Whitecourt)

When are meetings held?

Committee meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month (except July, and August) at 7:00pm at the Allan & Jean Millar Centre. Members receive an honorarium to attend meetings.

How much time does it take?

The time commitment varies from month (to month depending on activities. On average members commit 2-3 hours per month. Members are typically appointed for 3 year terms.

Committee Role:

To make recommendations to Council on policies and regulations related to:

- community issues that enhance, strengthen and stabilize family and community life;
- prevent family or community social breakdown;
- program equipment;
- playfields, and the planning and development of playgrounds and athletic fields;
- operation of recreation facilities (including the Allan & Jean Millar Centre, JDA Place, Carlan Services Community Resource Centre, Culture & Events Centre);
- growth and development of recreation activities;
- Whitecourt Transit.
