



MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION

TAKE PART, GIVE BACK

MANDATE: To deal with land use planning matters with particular emphasis on the Land Use Bylaw.

The Committee consists of:

- 2 Town Council Representatives
- 3 Public Members
- 1 Alternate Public Member

No person who is a member of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board can act as a member on the Municipal Planning Commission.

When are meetings held?

Based on applications, the Committee meets on the second and fourth Thursday of the month as necessary. Meetings are held at 4pm at the Town Administration Office.

How much time does it take?

On average, members commit 20 hours per year.



Committee Role:

The Municipal Planning Commission (MPC) assists Council with regard to the planning of orderly and economical development within Whitecourt.

MPC acts as the Development Authority on applications for development permits as prescribed in the Land Use Bylaw, and also acts as the Subdivision Approving Authority responsible to make decisions on subdivision applications in the manner prescribed by the Municipal Government Act and the Land Use Bylaw. As an advisory body to Council on planning and development matters, MPC reviews and provides recommendations to Council on Area Structure Plan proposals, and applications to amend and revise Whitecourt's planning bylaws.
