When are meetings held?

How much time does it take?

On average members commit 20-30 hours per year. This includes attendance at Committee meetings, as well as volunteering at various initiatives hosted by the Committee.

Committee Role:

To host local initiatives that increase awareness of the pillars of the Communities in Bloom Program, and its opportunities and benefits to the community, environment and quality of life.

To act as a liaison with the municipal authorities, and assist with various projects within the judging criteria when Whitecourt participates in the provincial or national competition.
