As things begin to wind down for the year, this is a great opportunity to complete file clean up in your office.



SANTA STRAWBERRIES

Ingredients:

- Fresh strawberries
- · Vanilla Frosting or Whipped Cream
- Black Icing Gel or Chia Seeds

Directions:

- 1. Slice off the very tip and the leafy part of the strawberries, and slice in half horizontally. Dab off the excess moisture on all cut sides with paper towel.
- 2. Put your vanilla frosting or whipped cream into either a piping bag or a Ziploc bag with the corner cut, and pipe it on the base of the strawberry to make Santa's head. Place the tip of the strawberry back on top, and pipe on a small dab of frosting/whipped cream to complete Santa's hat.
- 3. Use either your black icing gel or chia seeds to give Santa some eyes. Ready to serve!
