## MAY 21-24, 2025

To assist you with your spring cleaning, the Town of Whitecourt will be offering free disposal at the Whitecourt Regional Landfill from May 21-24, 2025.

Excludes industrial and commercial customers.

### DROP OFF DAY PREP ★

Whitecourt residents will be required to show their **Landfill Access Tag** to receive free disposal. Two pieces of identification showing your Whitecourt street address will also be accepted (i.e. driver's licence, tax notice, utility bill, etc.).

All items must be sorted, and bagged or bundled for disposal.

Residents will be responsible for unpacking and placing items in designated areas at the Landfill so be sure to wear appropriate footwear for the Landfill.

### DROP OFF HOURS ★

At the Whitecourt Regional Landfill  
Located 17kms east of Whitecourt on Highway 43.

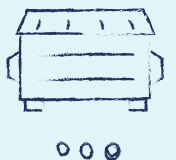

## ACCEPTED ITEMS ✓

THESE ITEMS CAN BE DISPOSED OF AT  
THE **WHITECOURT REGIONAL LANDFILL**

(No charge for Whitecourt residents May 21-24, 2025)

- » Air conditioners (including antifreeze)
- » Appliances (must be cleaned out)
  - Dishwashers
  - Dryers
  - Freezers
  - Fridges
  - Stoves
  - Washing Machines
- » Barbeques (propane tanks removed)
- » Bicycles
- » Car Parts (including antifreeze and batteries)
- » Electronics
  - Cell Phones
  - Computers
  - Fans
  - Hair dryers
  - Irons
  - Microwaves
  - Printers
  - Small Appliances (blender, toaster)
  - Telephones
  - Televisions
- » Exercise Machines
- » Floor coverings (carpet/rugs that are cut into 5 foot lengths, linoleum, tile, laminate, hard wood, etc.)
- » Furniture
  - Bed frames (metal, wood) and mattresses/box spring
  - Couches/Chairs
  - Dressers
  - Filing Cabinets (wood separated from metal)
  - Tables
- » Garbage - household (bagged)
- » Glass Doors/Patio Doors
- » Glass items
  - Glass Tables
  - Mirrors
  - Window Glass
- » Lawn Mowers - small motor (drain all fluids)
- » Light Fixtures
- » Metal Railings
- » Metal Downspouts
- » Motor oil, filters and containers (up to 20 litres)
- » Oil and Antifreeze (in original containers or labeled)
- » Plumbing Fixtures (must be clean)
  - Bathtubs
  - Sinks
  - Toilets
- » Propane Tanks/Bottles (empty, cannot be more than 40lbs)
- » Renovation/Demolition Materials
  - Asphalt shingles
  - Drywall
  - Kitchen cabinets
  - Siding
- » Styrofoam
- » Tires without rims (up to 22 inches)
- » Wood items (clean, untreated)
  - Branches, tree cuttings, stumps
  - Palettes (maximum 4 per household)
- » Treated wood (e.g. fence posts)

THESE ITEMS **CAN** BE DISPOSED OF AT THE  
**WHITECOURT TRANSFER STATION** (No charge)

Located at 3209 41 Avenue (1.2km east of 35 Street)  
Open daily from 10am to 6pm

- » Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFL bulbs)
- » Compostable materials (no weeds)
  - Grass Clippings
  - Leaves
- » Hazardous Waste
  - Aerosols
  - Fertilizer
  - Chemicals
  - Paint

THESE ITEMS **ARE ACCEPTED** FOR RECYCLING AT  
**STAPLES** (No charge)

- » Household Batteries (Batteries must be packaged in  
a plastic bag for acceptance.)

### GETTING INVOLVED

During the Take It or Leave It weekend, place unwanted but reusable items at the front of your property by the curb. Residents from across the community are then welcome to take these items to reuse – for free!

Mark your items with the word **FREE** using masking tape or stickers so that people know what's available for the taking.

All remaining items must be removed from your curbside by  
Monday, May 19.

- » Do not discard unwanted items on  
another resident's lawn.
